Introduction to Transpersonal Psychology

Transpersonal Psychology has been dubbed by Forbes Magazine the "Psychology of the Future". It is an exciting and deep dive into soul healing. It is the psychology that explores mankind's potential and evolution beyond their physical and mental limitations. This course reviews the origins and principles of Transpersonal Psychology. It also examines the progression of Transpersonal Psychology from Abraham Maslow's Humanistic Psychology to modern day. In Psychology today's article "Why Psychedelics Are Therapy's Next Frontier" stated "People describe ego-dissolution

as a diminished sense of self and an increase in the feeling of being at one with the universe, an experience felt as enriching." This class will explore the healing, expanding and evolving effects of different psychoactive plants in nature that have been used for millennia.

The Enneagram

The Enneagram, is both an ancient sacred geometry and modern model of the human psyche which is principally understood and taught as a typology of nine interconnected personality types. It is known to be over two thousand years old, dating back to the ancient Sufis. As a typology, the Enneagram defines nine personality types (sometimes called "enneatypes"), which are represented by the points of a geometric figure called an enneagram, which indicate some of the principal connections between the types. The Enneagram of Personality is promoted in both business management and spirituality. In business contexts, it is often promoted as a means to gain insights into workplace interpersonal dynamics; in spirituality it is commonly presented as a path to states of enlightenment and essence. Proponents in both contexts say it has aided in self-awareness, self-understanding, and self-development.
